This week we were made aware of two unrelated, confirmed COVID-19 cases at our Flowery Branch, GA production facility. As we have done in previous incidences, we took immediate action by quarantining these two employees and those that they came into contact with. We also are ensuring that those affected are being properly cared for, and are fully compensated while away from the facility.

In addition to quarantining affected employees away from the facility, we continue to have significant safety measures in place to protect our employees within the facility including: temperature screening of employees upon entry, the requiring of masks to be worn inside the building, increased size of common area space (lunch and break areas) to allow for social distancing in those venues, protective barriers erected between employees whose jobs do not allow for full social distancing, and continuous cleaning of surfaces with EPA approved cleaner known to kill COVID-19.

We are grateful to everyone in our facilities who is working hard to provide the safest environment possible, while enabling the company to continue to provide the country with the essential food products it needs. We are confident with the amazing people that work here, we will continue to be able to do so.
