In the last two weeks, we were made aware of four new confirmed COVID-19 cases at our Oakwood, GA production facility. As in previous instances, we took immediate action and the employees, as well as those they came into contact with, have been quarantined. All are being properly cared for, and fully compensated, while away from our facility. As we have seen with nearly all prior COVID cases, our contact tracing shows these cases were all contracted outside of the facility, giving us confidence in our current safety protocols which we will continue to employ.

As has been the case throughout this COVID pandemic, quarantining affected employees, and employing preventative ongoing safety measures (including temperature screening, requiring of masks to be worn, use of size-increased common-space areas [to allow for better social distancing], placement of protective barriers between employees where appropriate, and continuous cleaning of surfaces with EPA approved cleaner known to kill COVID-19) will remain in place to keep everyone as safe as possible.

One additional note: As a follow-up to the news release we posted two weeks ago, when we announced the testing and quarantining of all affected employees at our Torrance, CA facility, we have identified only 3 additional COVID cases in that facility since undertaking this complete testing effort. We believe that this measure to test all employees has been very beneficial in removing the virus from the facility, and we are grateful to all the employees in this facility who worked together to rapidly complete this testing and ensure that we continue to maintain the safest possibly environment.
