

## **News Release**

This week we were made aware of one confirmed COVID-19 case at our Torrance, CA production facility. As we have done in other instances, immediate action was taken and the employee, along with those they came into contact with, have been quarantined and are being properly cared for, and fully compensated, while away from our facility.

Quarantining employees has proven to be effective, and we continue to have no related cases coming from within the facility. Our ongoing safety measures of temperature screening, requiring of masks to be worn, use of size-increased common-space areas (to allow for better social distancing), placement of protective barriers between employees whose jobs do not allow for full social distancing, and continuous cleaning of surfaces with EPA approved cleaner known to kill COVID-19 also remain in place. As employee safety is our #1 concern, we plan to continue these safety precautions indefinitely at the current time.

We are grateful to our employees for their continued diligence in following these measures, and their dedication to continuing to produce essential food products for the country.
